

HEAD OVER HEELS FOR TEACHING

PAGE	RESOURCE	HOW TO USE
8-9	Invites	Use to invite administrators, special guest readers, parents Print single sided or double sided (page 8 & 9)
10-15	Book Tasting Signs	Display the day before and the day of the event-choose color scheme
16-17	Menu	Print back to back and fold into a tri-fold
18-19	Placemats	Two versions: photos show page 16 backed on black construction paper, use 17 for students to show creativity
20	Name Tents	Print and fold in half to make a tent, write student names
21	Reservation List	When students walk in the door, confirm their reservation and give table number
22-23	Book Tasting Table Signs	Choose option to display at each table
24-31	Table Number Signs	Choose option to display at each table. Pages 26-29 are table tent signs, fold in half.
32	Reflection Napkin	Students reflect on their book tasting experience
33-34	Bookmarks	Students record book titles to read after event
*other file	Genre Posters	Two versions: one b/w and one color

I plan to hold this event 2-3 times a year to introduce my students to new genres and book choices. This would be a great evening event to share with parents too.

Included in this resource: placemats, reflection napkins, bookmarks, genre signs with definitions, event signs, table signs, name tents, teacher directions, pages of photos in action.

\*\*Choose the style and items you'd like printed, many of the resources have two options. Posters (other file in the zip file) have a black and white option that can be printed on colored paper or a color version.

## Prepping for the event:

- 1. Decide how many tables you want to set up (that's how many different genres will be featured).

  Decision may be based on book availability (classroom library and media center).
  - \*\*\*(5 tables/genres are shown in photos)
- 2. Select 10-15 books to feature for each genre. I placed mine on a serving tray in the center of the table.
- 3. Decorate room for book tasting. Post signs day before to excite students! I didn't tell them what the event was about, I just posted the sign to pique their curiosity!
- 4. Students start at one genre table and rotate through all tables during the event. Give them about 5-6 minutes to read the first few pages of the book selected. \*Book selection should be quick, remind them they are just "tasting," they are not committed to finish the book. This will ease any "fears" of not selecting the perfect book or being stuck with a book they don't like.
- 5. Students complete the genre or book type, title, and describe the cover.

- 6. After students read for about 5 minutes, they complete the questions about their book. (what they thought about the book, author's hook, would they read the book, and rating). Rating can be discussed whole class or students can decide individually (1-10, 5 stars, A-F, etc.)
- 7.. Students share their thoughts and feelings about their book at their table group. This allows them to elaborate their thinking and introduce their book to others, possibly interesting other students to more books.
- 8. To rotate, I ring the service bell and they move to the next table. Same process with all five tables: choose a book, answer the first questions, read, complete questions, share and discuss.
- 9. After the book tasting experience, students reflect on their reflection napkins. \*I served light refreshments during this time.

Bookmarks can be completed with their future must read books they were introduced to at the book tasting. They may be titles from their menu or another group member's sharing of a book.

Included in the genre signs/definitions is also graphic novels and books in a series (these are not genres, but types of books). I included these to introduce my students to a different format of book and to possibly hook them on a series.

After using the placemat as part of your book tasting event to "taste" books, students could fill in words, phrases, quotes from books, etc. to represent their experience.

\*An additional placemat "Book Tasting Graffiti" is included if you'd like to use separate from the regular placemat.



Signs could also be used in a table top frame (clear acrylic) or simply lay on the tables.



I served some cookies and punch after they rotated through all five genre tables. They ate while completing their reflection napkin.

To enhance the experience of the book tasting event you can include:

- tablecloths (dollar tree has red/white checked and other plastic tablecloths)
- serving tray to hold books (serves as a centerpiece)
- tea light holders/candle holders with battery operated lights
- bell to ring to rotate tables
- chef's hat and/or apron to "serve" books
