<p><b>Find the original footage, figures and research for your source.</b></p> <p>Confirming the source or origin of the posted article, pic, quote or video means you are better able to determine how real it is. Don't let others summarize it for you!</p>	<p><b>Analyze the headline.</b></p> <p>What is the purpose? It is to make you feel something strongly? Change your mind? Present basic facts? Is there emotional language?</p>	<p><b>Check your own bias!</b></p> <p>News that comfortably fits your worldview cannot be neutral. Be sure your search terms are neutral. Double-check your own bias before using or reposting!</p>	<p><b>Look to fact checkers</b> such as Snopes.com, Mythbusters or Politifact. These sites are dedicated to rumor debunking and fact checking all while being neutral.</p>	<p><b>Exert self control!</b></p> <p>Be 100% certain that the news is true before sharing. It is your job to stop rumors and misleading stories!</p>
