

## Kagan Cooperative Strategies

<p><b>Timed Pair Share</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Announce the topic and tell the students how long each student will have to share.</li> <li>2. The topic or question must be open ended and allow for lengthy responses.</li> <li>3. Give students time to think about the topic</li> <li>4. In pairs, Student A shares for the set amount of time while Student B listens</li> <li>5. Student B thanks Student A and gives feedback (academic scripts)</li> <li>6. Partners switch roles</li> <li>7. For a more challenging option the students would be asked to come up with and agree on the topic to be discussed.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Ideas for Your Classroom</b></p>
<p><b>Rally Robin</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Present the students with a question.</li> <li>2. The question should allow students to provide more of a list of answers.</li> <li>3. Give students time to think.</li> <li>4. Partners go back and forth listing answers for the given amount of time.</li> </ol> <p><b>Rally Coach</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Student A solves the problem while student B watches, listens, coaches, and praises</li> <li>2. Switch roles</li> </ol>	<p><b>Ideas for Your Classroom</b></p>
<p><b>Inside-Outside Circle</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Prepare questions or provide a question card for each student.</li> <li>2. Students pair up.</li> <li>3. One student from each pair moves to form a large circle facing inward</li> <li>4. Remaining students find and face their partners forming 2 concentric circles</li> <li>5. Inside students ask a question from their card and outside circle students answer.</li> <li>6. Inside circle students praise and/or coach.</li> <li>7. Switch roles</li> <li>8. Partners trade question cards</li> <li>9. Inside circle students rotate clockwise to next student</li> </ol>	<p><b>Ideas for Your Classroom</b></p>
<p><b>Quiz-Quiz Trade</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Students prepare a question card.</li> <li>2. Students partner up and Student A quizzes Student B</li> <li>3. Student A praises or coaches</li> <li>4. Switch roles</li> <li>5. Partners thank each other and trade cards</li> <li>6. Repeat with new partner</li> </ol>	<p><b>Ideas for Your Classroom</b></p>
