### **UNFILLED HOLDS**

As of April 1, newly updated unfilled holds procedures have gone into effect for the consortium. Previously, holds in Overdrive never expired and unfilled holds could stay on a record forever, even if that title was no longer available or was weeded from the collection. Going forward, Overdrive will automatically remove unfilled holds that are more than two years old on a quarterly basis - January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1.

Libraries will receive a report of affected titles and instructions for how to run reports at the library level in advance of the removal dates

The goal for cleaning out old holds is to clean up our catalog and have a more accurate measure of demand and wait times.
